


Certificate in New Pastoral Theology







Certificate in New Pastoral Theology

What is the programme about?

This course is designed to facilitate the Human, Spiritual and Pastoral Development of participants at a time when there is growing awareness of the importance of collaborative ministry in the Church. The focus of this Certificate in Pastoral Theology is precisely the living relevance of doctrine. It prepares people for ministry through theological reflection, faith formation and participative learning. It is built around those elements which are considered relevant for effective pastoral ministry in contemporary Ireland.

Who will this course appeal to?

This course would appeal to anyone who would like to expand their knowledge and skills in Religious Education and Theology, and those who would like to know their Christian faith better. On completion they will receive a recognised Certificate in Pastoral Theology. It will equip participants with the necessary, knowledge, attitudes and understanding for pastoral care in a wide variety of contexts, schools, local communities, youth work, voluntary organisations, adult faith formation groups, family ministry, support groups, parish liturgy groups and parish development groups.

Course Details

Over the past few years the Institute of Technology Carlow has run a number of valuable courses in Pastoral Ministry at the former St. Peter's College Seminary that have been of real benefit to the people of the Wexford area. This is a new Certificate in Pastoral Theology and will take place over a 13 week period, on Tuesdays and Thursday evenings from 7.00 pm to 9.15 pm.

What Subjects will I study?

- An Introduction to Moral Theology
- Father, Son and Holy Spirt: Introduction to the Theology of God
- Introduction to Sacred Scripture
- The Church: Living Faith Community
- Liturgy and Sacraments
- Pastoral Theology
